Jon is Distinguished Professor of Public Health at the University of Technology Sydney, Director of the Australian Research Centre in Complementary and Integrative Medicine (UTS:ARCCIM) and a Fulbright Senior Scholar. He is also National Convenor of the Special Interest Group on Complementary Medicine at the Public Health Association of Australia (PHAA) and is one of only eight academics worldwide to have been appointed as Senior Fellow on the Oxford International Primary Care Research Leadership Program, Nuffield Department of Primary Care Health Sciences at the University of Oxford.

Jon has authored over 450 academic publications and attracted more than \$19M in external research funding. Under Jon's Directorship, UTS:ARCCIM hosts the only international program advancing the critical public health and health services research of traditional, complementary and integrative medicine (TCIM) in the world - currently leading over 40 projects in 15 countries.

UTS:ARCCIM houses over 50 affiliated researchers supervising the largest pool of PhDs in TCIM in Australia (>45). Jon's research interests include practice-based research network design, leadership, research translation and implementation science. Jon has mentored over 60 early-career researchers to date and in 2017 he received the PHAA National Mentor of the Year Award.
